

Fundraising ideas!



Go Green Day - wear something green and donate £1 to help protect rainforests

Coffee morning - hold a rainforest awareness assembly followed by a coffee morning and invite parents along

Collect sponsorship - hold a sponsored: walk, silence, swim, bike ride, fun run, sing, dance, skip

Raffle - you could source prizes from local businesses and/or parents and sell tickets

Quiz - hold a rainforest themed quiz. This works well run by teacher for pupils, by older pupils for younger classes, or even pupils setting quizzes for parents after school.

Bring and buy / Jumble sale - donate unwanted toys/books/games/uniform etc.

Hold a dance - perhaps decorate your school hall for a rainforest themed disco!

Auctions - have an entertaining sale of donated items or services. Source prizes from local business or ask for donations of gifts/services via your school newsletter

Get cooking - hold a pancake breakfast in your school. Invite friends, parents and teachers to attend.

Hold a 'Great Rainforest Bake-off' - bake items and sell them to pupils and teachers at break time.

Hold a car wash event - get the neighbourhood involved as you scrub for a good cause

Coin trail - ask every pupil to bring in spare change, lay them all out in a trail and see how far around the school you can get

Sponge throw - Ask pupils to donate in return for getting to launch soapy sponges at teachers!

Treasure hunt - Put together a treasure hunt, split pupils into pairs or teams and let the detective work begin! Ask a local business to donate a prize for the winning pair/team, and set a suggested donation amount for entering
